Who: Open to applicants in grades K-5. Prior 4-H membership is **NOT** required. Limited to the **First 30** applicants.

What: The Davenport 4-H Afterschool Program will provide a structured recreational learning environment for K-5 students during after school hours.

When: The Davenport 4-H Afterschool program will run on school days only. Generally the program will operate from 2:45 pm -5:15 pm, but when school is scheduled for only a half day, the After school Program will adjust and provide programming 12:15 pm until 5:15 pm.

Where: The Afterschool Program will operate in the Davenport Elementary School computer lab room 109. Parents will pick up their students by 5:15 pm at the elementary school computer lab room 109.

Cost: \$7.00 /day for the first child and \$5.00 for each additional child. (Financial aid available to those who qualify.) **Make checks payable to : Lincoln County Youth Program**
