The course is designed to prepare students for employment with the entry level skills as nursing assistant certified in nursing homes, hospitals, clinics, long-term care facilities, home or community health agencies or other health care facilities. The content includes, but is not limited to, basic essential of health care, interpersonal skills, medical terminology, structure and function of human body, legal and ethical responsibilities, safe and efficient work, health and safety including Cardio-pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) – health saver level, employability skills. Using the academic foundation of medical terminology, accurate mathematical operations and computations, and knowledge of the life sciences they will demonstrate technical skill competency in real life health care situations. The program criteria dictated by DSHS for a standard CNA program.

**Who:** Seniors get first priority but we may take Juniors depending on enrollment.

**Hours:** 7:30 - 10:30 am (This program will run in the mornings, with a possibility of a 8:00 am start).

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**Credits:** 1 CTE Credit, .5 Anatomy & Physiology credit per semester (3 credits for the year). There is a possibility for students to receive College Credit from Spokane Community College.

**Certification:** Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)
